Cosmetology Performance Objective:

The licensed Cosmetician will be prepared to seek profitable employment as a skin care specialist, skin care salon manager, salon owner, or product demonstrator. They will be versed in all areas of the skin care profession.

The course of study for students enrolled in a Cosmetician program shall consist of sixteen hundred (600) clock hours which include a minimum of 190 clock hours of technical instruction and practical operations covering all practices constituting the art of cosmetician. The minimum combined total clock hours of 600, include the technical instruction phase and opportunity for the student to acquire the necessary skills through practical applications developed under the supervision of the school's instructors.

Electrical Facial include the use of electrical modalities, dermal lights and electrical apparatus, for facials and skin care purposes: however, machines capable of producing an electrical current shall not be used to stimulate so as to contact, or for the purposed of contact, or for the purpose of contacting, the muscles of the body or face. Chemical Facials include chemical skin peels, packs, masks and scrubs. Training shall emphasize that only the non-living, uppermost layers of facial skin, known as the epidermis, may be performed in accordance with Section 992 regarding skin peeling.)</p>	70	140
